

VHIR MASTER'S SCHOLARSHIPS

CALL 2026-2027

In partnership with:



This call will offer 2 scholarships to the top students of 2026-2027 class. The beneficiaries will be exempted from paying tuition fees (up to 2.550€) for the Master's Degree in Translational Biomedical Research. Academic and administrative taxes are not included.



Candidates should fulfill the following **eligibility criteria** at the time of the call deadline:

- Have been accepted to the Master's Degree for the academic year 2026-2027.
- Have obtained their Graduate Degree after January 1, 2024.
- Have a grade point average (GPA) equal to or greater than 7,5. In case of studies taken abroad, the average grade must be calculated by the Agència Nacional d'Avaluació de la Qualitat i Acreditació (ANECA). Applicants must request ANECA their equivalence study. - Upon acceptance of the grant candidates have to enroll to the Master's Degree by full-time (60 ECTS per year).
- Selected candidates must do their curricular internship in a research group of Vall d'Hebron Campus.
- At the time of acceptance selected candidates must state that they are not holding other grant that covers the cost of tuition for the master's degree (MEC, AGAUR, etc).

Application must be submitted by email at master.research@vhir.org, which will have attached the documents below:

- **Attested copy of the official and complete academic transcript of the degree** stating the grade point average, the number of credits of each subject or, if this is not possible, the number of hours. In case of studies taken abroad, the transcripts equivalence study of the Spanish Education Ministry.
- **Attested copy of the academic degree** or the proof of payment thereof.¹

AMOUNT:

The beneficiaries will be exempted from paying a part from the tuition of the Master's Degree in Translational Biomedical Research (2.550,00 €)

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Candidates will be selected according to the GPA of their transcripts. The scholarship will be offered to the two best students.

In the event of a tie, first applications will be prioritized.

EVALUATION COMMITTEE:

The Evaluation Committee will be formed by the Master's Coordinator and the responsible for VHIR Academia.

ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT:

Selected students must accept the grant before the 18th September 2026.

If any of the selected students renounce to the scholarship, it will be allocated to the next candidate on the waiting list.

The failure to issue the master certificate for academic reasons, attendance or abandonment of the candidate, will imply that the recipient has to repay the aid².

¹ If the student still not have the official degree certificate, complete academic transcripts will be enough whenever the provided document states that all credits of studies are achieved.

² Severe illness, disability or other exceptional situations may be considered by VHIR's Direction.
